NEBRASKA FARM BUREAU DISTRICT EVALUATION COMMITTEES (DEC)

Description & Administrative Guidelines

PURPOSE: To evaluate and recommend candidates worthy of receiving the Nebraska Farm Bureau Political Action Committee (NEFB-PAC) endorsement prior to each primary and general election.

APPOINTMENT: The Committees serve at the pleasure of NEFB-PAC Executive Committee.

FACILITATOR: The meeting will be facilitated by a staff coordinator or a State Board Member.

MEETINGS: Authorized meetings shall be called by the NEFB-PAC Executive Committee.

TENURE: Committee members are appointed by the County Farm Bureau Board of Directors to serve one, four-year term.

AUTHORITY: The Committees may meet as often as needed subject to time limitations and requirements of the NEFB-PAC Executive Committee.

RELATIONSHIPS: The Committees shall work with the staff coordinator assigned to them. The Committees may freely communicate with other staff members in execution of its duties. They may also request information from staff and/or outside consultants subject to limitations of staff and/or budget constraints.

Position Description

TITLE: Member, NEFB-PAC District Evaluation Committee

FUNCTION: To evaluate and recommend candidates worthy of receiving the NEFB-PAC endorsement prior to each primary and general election.

REPORTABILITY: To communicate ideas and recommendations to the NEFB-PAC Executive Committee as requested.

AUTHORITY: Appointed by the County Farm Bureau Board of Directors of which they are representing.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. To participate in all meetings of the DEC regarding the process of evaluating and selecting candidates.
2. To assist in the examination of credentials and background information on candidates running for public office.
3. To encourage County Farm Bureaus' involvement and participation in the evaluation of candidates and support endorsed candidates.
4. To provide representation for County Farm Bureaus during the selection process of candidates.
5. To evaluate candidates running for public office.
6. To recommend candidates for the NEFB-PAC endorsement.
