3rd Congressional District Input Form

The Nebraska Farm Bureau (NEFB) Board of Directors approved a process for early endorsement of incumbent candidates who have previously been designated “Friends of Agriculture.” For an incumbent candidate to qualify for an early endorsement they must meet the following criteria:

1. Positive voting record on major issues affecting agriculture.
2. Degree of special effort to introduce, support, or oppose legislation in accordance with the position of Farm Bureau.
3. Attendance at Farm Bureau sponsored meetings or communication with county Farm Bureau members on legislative issues and a degree of communication with Farm Bureau personnel on legislative developments.
4. Previous “Friend of Agriculture” designation.
5. Consensus of the County Farm Bureaus they represent.

For the upcoming election cycle, the NEFB Board asks county leaders in Congressional District 3 to consider Congressman Adrian Smith for early endorsement.

Congressman Adrian Smith (NE-3):

- Has been endorsed as a Nebraska Farm Bureau “Friend of Agriculture” six times
- Farm Bureau voting record: 85%
- Is extremely accessible to NEFB leaders and members both in Washington, D.C. as well as around his large Congressional District
- Regularly reaches out to NEFB to consult on legislation that is introduced.
- Serves in a significant leadership position on the House Ways & Means Committee, giving Nebraska’s farmers and ranchers an influential voice in trade, tax, and health care policy negotiations.
- Helped develop and pass the first major revisions to the federal tax code in over 30 years including a reduction in tax rates, a doubled estate tax exemption, and helped protect the ability for farmers and ranchers to fully deduct their property taxes on their federal return.
- Continues the fight to increase access to markets around the world, reduce the regulatory burden on our farm and ranch families, and protect the Renewable Fuel Standard (RFS).
- Supported passage of the 2018 Farm Bill which not only offered a series of reforms to both the commodity and conservation titles, but more importantly, protected federal crop insurance.
- Directly represented agriculture in trade negotiations during the renegotiation of the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA), which became the United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement (USMCA).
- Led the effort to oppose elimination of 1031 exchanges and stepped-up basis which would have been used to pay for the reckless Build Back Better Act.
- Supported legislation to provide more price transparency and price discovery in cattle markets.
