



2022 PRIORITIES

- **EXPAND** rural connectivity to secure high-speed, high-quality internet access statewide.
- **PROMOTE** and support animal agriculture, including growth and development opportunities.
- **SUPPORT** rural economic development opportunities to grow rural Nebraska and enhance profitability for farm and ranch families.
- **REDUCE** Nebraska's overreliance on property taxes and seek a more balanced system to fund education.
- **ENSURE** environment and climate initiatives work for farm and ranch families.
- **GROW** markets, domestic and international, for Nebraska agricultural products.
- **ENSURE** regulations and programs work for farm and ranch families.
- **GROW** Nebraska Farm Bureau Political Action Committee (NEFB-PAC) resources and elect Nebraska Farm Bureau endorsed candidates.
- **INCREASE** engagement in Nebraska Farm Bureau's advocacy efforts.

STATE LEGISLATURE

- Secured passage of historical property and income tax relief. *(LB 873)*
- **\$6,947 avg.** per farm/ranch in additional property tax relief annually.



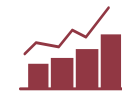
- **\$100 million** for broadband expansion in rural Nebraska. *(Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act)*
- **\$10 million** for precision agriculture infrastructure grants. *(LB 1144)*
 - Higher download and upload speeds.
 - Holds internet providers accountable for delivering broadband as advertised.



- Annual tax credit for livestock expansion **raised** from \$1 million to \$10 million. *(Enhanced Livestock Modernization Act)*
- **Transparency** in cattle markets by expanded price reporting, establishing a cattle contract library, and mandatory minimums on cash sales. *(Cattle Price Discovery and Transparency Act)*



- **\$225 million** for bridge replacement and repairs. *(Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act)*
- **\$358 million** over five years to improve water infrastructure. *(Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act)*



- Released **Annual Trade Report** on Nebraska agriculture.
- Put pressure on current administration to move forward on trade policy with clear priorities.
- Secured temporary waiver to allow for sale of E-15 year-round.



- **Stopped** the proposed elimination of stepped-up basis. *(Build Back Better Plan)*
- **Opposed** 30x30 initiative. *(Over 400 members took action)*
- **Pushed back** against SEC Climate Rule. *(Over 200 members contacted SEC)*
- **Lifted ban** on Enlist and Enlist Duo for spring planting.
